## Instructions frules:

- 1. Get a team together and pick a team name
- 2. Start hunting!
- 3. Most tasks will lead to a location where you will take a picture and post it to Instagram with the task number, your team's name, and the hashtag #NovaSeekers16. Some locations like professor's offices will only be accessible at certain times of day so make sure to read the tasks carefully.
- 4. If a task asks for a picture of your team at a location there must be at least one team member in the picture.
- 5. All submissions must be posted to Instagram by noon on October 31st. The Winners will be determined based on which team has earned the most points, and will be announced at the library event on the same day.
- **6. Don't forget!** In order to get credit for completing a task you must post it to Instagram and include 1) Task Number, 2)Team name, 3) the hashtag #NovaSeekers16

\*\*\*WARNING\*\*\* the Ministry of Magic has forbidden the use of time turners which means you will need to plan carefully and pay special attention to the tasks marked with a golden snitch. These tasks will earn you more points, but they can only be completed on specific days and times."

A final reminder: things aren't always what they seem. Speak the magic words in the right place, and you may find yourself on an unexpected adventure...



Tasks may be completed in any order.

- 1. The Floo network and broomsticks are great green alternatives to muggle forms of transportation, but muggles care about the planet too! There are 5 Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certified buildings on Villanova's campus. Take a team picture in front of one of them. 5/pts
- 2. Dumbledore's Army had to train diligently in order to defeat the Death Eaters, just like the NROTC, which has been a part of Villanova University since World War Two (1946). On Tuesdays NROTC Students wear their service uniforms, find an NROTC student in uniform introduce yourself and ask if you can take a picture with them for the scavenger hunt. 10/pts

Go to the Office of Student Involvement during their hours of operation and learn about some of the campus organizations that would give you an opportunity to be an ally to different communities, write down at least 3 different groups you learned about and post a picture of the list to Instagram. 10/pts
- 7. Oh no! Dolores Umbridge has assigned you lines for saying that nargles ate your homework! Find the campus writing center, then take a picture of yourself outside the center holding a sheet of paper filled with "I must not tell lies." 5/pts
- 8. O.W.Ls are coming up! Find the math center and take a picture outside holding up the answer to this problem:

Two owls leave Hogwarts to deliver acceptance letters at 5 am, traveling in opposite directions at 40 and 50 mph respectively. At what time will they be 450 miles apart?

You will only get credit if the answer is correct, so if you need help ask one of the math tutors. 10/pts

9. All aboard the Hogwarts Express! Take a picture of at least two of your team members at one of the campus train stations, or take pictures at all 3 train stations for a total of 15 points. 5/pts per station total possible 15/pts

10. Go to SAC room 205 and take a picture with Dumbledore the Dog. **15/pts**O 1-3pm, Tues through Fri

11. "Be careful of the Venomous Tentacula, it's teething!" Meet Professor Sprout (Lindsay Bair) at the campus greenhouse located between Mendel and the train station and get a picture with one of her plants. 20/pts

- 26. Nicholas Flamel is the oldest wizard in the Harry Potter universe. Take a picture of a teammate outside the oldest building on campus drinking the Elixir of Life (a non-alcoholic beverage of your choice), but be careful: rumor has it that this building is haunted. 5/pts
- 27. Practice your divination skills at this prime stargazing spot. In addition to posting a picture of a teammate (10pts), channel your inner Trelawny for a prediction based on your observation (10 additional points). Total possible 20/pts

  - 29. If Harry and Ginny wanted to sneak off to snog there is a tree on campus that they might seek out. Take a picture under the kissing tree, no kissing required. 5/pts
  - 30. Using a person or object's true name can evoke powerful magic. There is a well-known statue on campus that is commonly referred to by its nickname, but its true name is "The Awakening." Identify this statue and take a picture in front of it. 5/pts

Take a picture in front of his statue. 5/pts
- 33. In Harry Potter and The Deathly Hallows Lord Voldemort speaks these words to the students of Hogwarts "I know that many of you will want to fight. Some of you may even think that to fight is wise. But this is a folly." Take a picture in front of the building known as "Fedigan's Folly," but wait! You'll need to do a little sleuthing first, take a picture in front of Fedigan Hall and you won't get any points at all. 5/pts
- 34. Did you know Villanova has its own Quidditch team? Keepers, chasers and beaters play while the Seekers try to capture the Golden Snitch (a fleet-footed runner in yellow). Members of the team will be wearing yellow all day on Tuesday, the 25th. If you spot one, DON'T grab the snitch; instead, ASK to take a picture with the player and post it to Instagram for points. Pictures taken without permission won't win you any favors! 10/pts
- 35. Just like Professor McGonagall is Head of Gryffindor House, Noel Dolan is Head of Villanova's ACS Learning Communities. Go to SAC 131 and take her Transfiguration test. If you pass, you win points for your team! 15/pts
